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ABSTRAK

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**Hubungan Pengetahuan, Sikap Dan Praktik Mahasiswa Korp Suka Rela (KSR)
Dalam Pertolongan Pertama Gawat Darurat Di Perguruan Tinggi Pekalongan**

Latar Belakang: Gawat darurat adalah kondisi yang mengancam jiwa yang dapat terjadi kapan, dimana dan kapan saja. Keadaan gawat darurat dapat terjadi pada mahasiswa di lingkungan perguruan tinggi. Agar tidak memperparah keadaan korban diperlukan pengetahuan, sikap dan praktik dalam melakukan pertolongan pertama secara efisien.

Tujuan: Mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan, sikap dan praktik mahasiswa KSR (Korp Suka Rela) dalam pertolongan pertama gawat darurat di Perguruan Tinggi Pekalongan.

Metode: Desain penelitian yang digunakan adalah deskriptif korelatif. Jumlah responden dalam penelitian ini sebanyak 306 mahasiswa KSR yang didapatkan dari teknik total sampling. Pengambilan data dilakukan menggunakan kuesioner *emergency management*. Uji statistik dalam penelitian ini menggunakan uji *Chi-Square*.

Hasil: Penelitian ini menunjukkan hasil responden 184 (60,1%) memiliki pengetahuan baik, sikap positif 273 (89,2%) dan praktik baik 225 (73,5%). Hasil

Chi square menunjukkan bahwa ada hubungan pengetahuan, sikap dan praktik mahasiswa KSR (Korp Suka Rela) dalam pertolongan pertama gawat darurat di Perguruan Tinggi Pekalongan dengan $p\text{ value} = <0,001$.

Simpulan: Hasil penelitian diketahui ada hubungan pengetahuan, sikap dan praktik mahasiswa KSR dalam pertolongan pertama gawat darurat. Diharapkan mahasiswa KSR rutin dalam mengikuti pelatihan pertolongan pertama dari PMI untuk meningkatkan pengetahuan, sikap dan praktik pertolongan pertama.

ABSTRACT

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The Correlation of Knowledge, Attitudes, and Practices of Voluntary Corps (KSR) Students in Emergency First Aid at Some Universities in Pekalongan

Background: An emergency is a life-threatening condition; can happen in anytime and any places. This situation can occur in students in a college environment. In order not to worsen the victim's condition, knowledge, attitude and practice are needed to provide first aid efficiently.

Objective: to investigate the correlation of knowledge, attitudes, and practices of voluntary corps (KSR) students in emergency first aid at some universities in Pekalongan

Method: it is a correlative descriptive study. There were 306 students of Voluntary Corps as the samples using a total sampling technique. Meanwhile, data collecting used the questionnaire of emergency management and Chi-Square test was applied as the statistical test.

Result: the result stated the respondents who have a good knowledge were 184 students (60,1%), who have positive attitudes were 273 students (89,2%), and who have good practices were 225 students (73,5%). Besides, Chi square indicates there is correlation among knowledge, attitudes, and practices of Voluntary Corps students in emergency first aid at some universities in Pekalongan with $p\text{ value} = <0,001$.

Conclusion: the conclusion is there there is correlation among knowledge, attitudes, and practices of Voluntary Corps students in emergency first aid. Therefore, the students are expected to regularly participate in first aid training from the Indonesian Red Cross to improve knowledge, attitudes, and practices of first aid.
