**An Overview of Self Stigma of Residents Assisted by Drug Abuse in Class 2 A of Jail Pekalongan and Its Relationship with Self Esteem.**

The people that use drugs, especially those in the jail, have a high self-stigma so that it can affect their self-esteem. This study aims to identify an overview of selfstigma in citizens and its relationship with self-esteem. It is a quantitative study with a correlation description using a cross-sectional approach. The technique of sampling using total sampling. The measuring instrument used the SASSS (Substance Abuse Self Stigma Scale) questionnaire and self-esteem from Rosenberg with Indonesian version. The analysis of the data using linear regression. The results of this study showed an average self-stigma score of 85.91. Meanwhile, the average self-esteem shows a score of 25.24. The results of this study also showed that there was no relationship between self-stigma and self-esteem in the assisted residents in the class 2 A of Jail in Pekalongan city with a p value of 0.528. This research that has been carried out shows that there is no relationship between self-stigma and self-esteem in assisted residents in class 2 A of Jail in Pekalongan city with drug abuse case with a p value of 0.528 each (p value >0.05).
